MRCP vs. ERCP



Magnetic resonance cholangiopancreatography allows evaluation of the biliary tree in a noninvasive manner, in patients with suspected bile duct obstruction.



It can diagnose bile duct obstruction in approximately 95-100% of the cases and can determine the level of obstruction to 85-100% of cases. Bile duct obstruction is diagnosed with maximal dimension of the common bile duct measured on coronal source images at 7 mm in patients with gallbladders and 10mm in patients after cholecystectomy.

Schedule the patient for an MRI
NPO 6 hours
Results in 45 minutes
